The panel members picked out the winners for both FY 20-21 and FY 21-22 across six categories.

Dr Varaprasad Reddy, who overcame the unethical and bad experiences and set the prices for vaccines in India for 11 years since the launch of Shantha Biotechnics, said "We have great doctors, great engineers in our country but not great leaders. The vaccine scenario has changed considerably in India. Currently, we are strong in production but we should collaborate with other countries for joint development and own the patent rights, to become global leaders."
