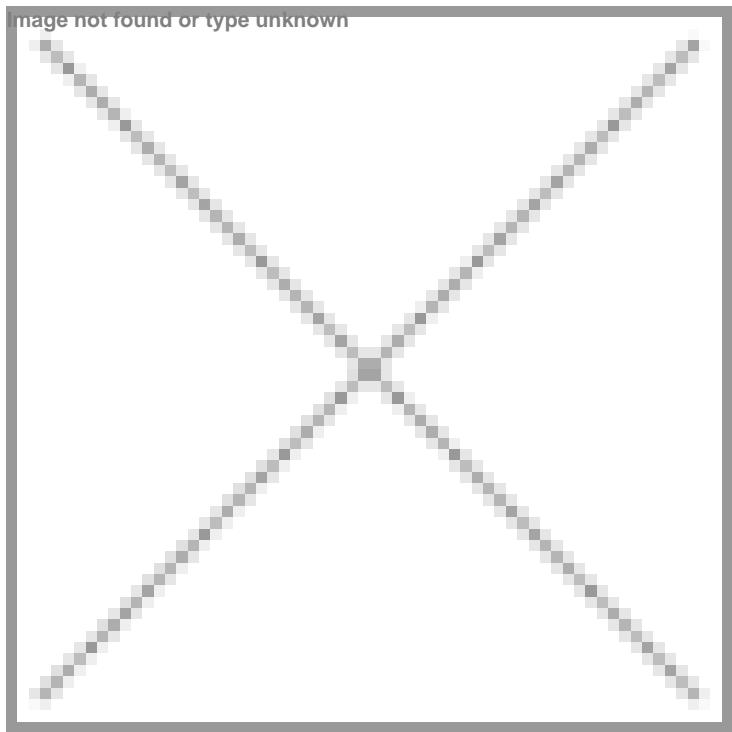


Clirnet partners with American Association of Physicians of Indian Origin
