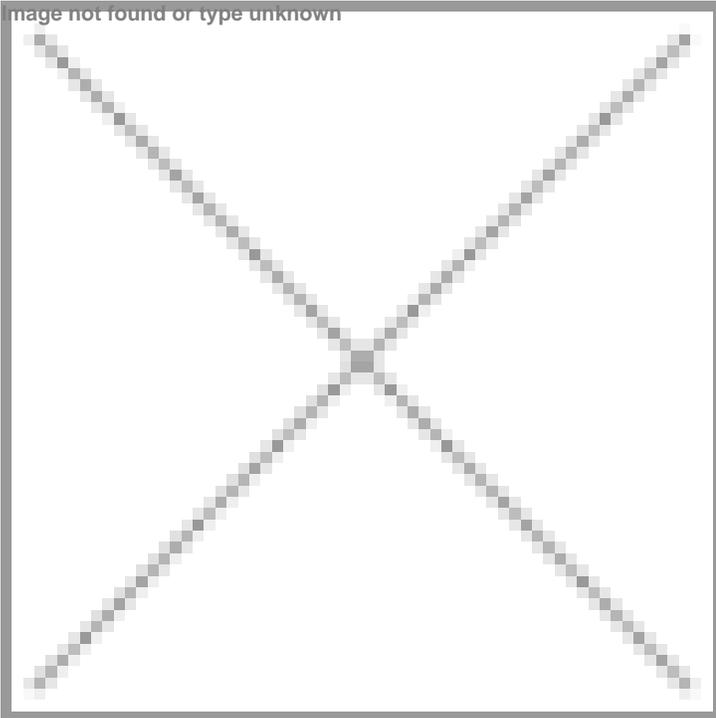


Lupin acquires Huminsulin from Lilly to enhance diabetes portfolio
