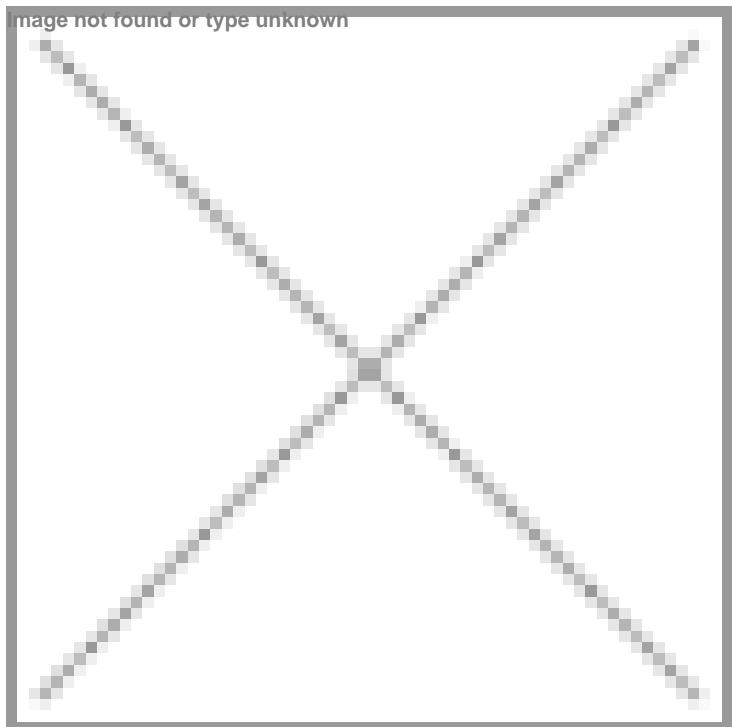


Medtronic and Symbiosis International open state-of-the-art experience centre in Pune
