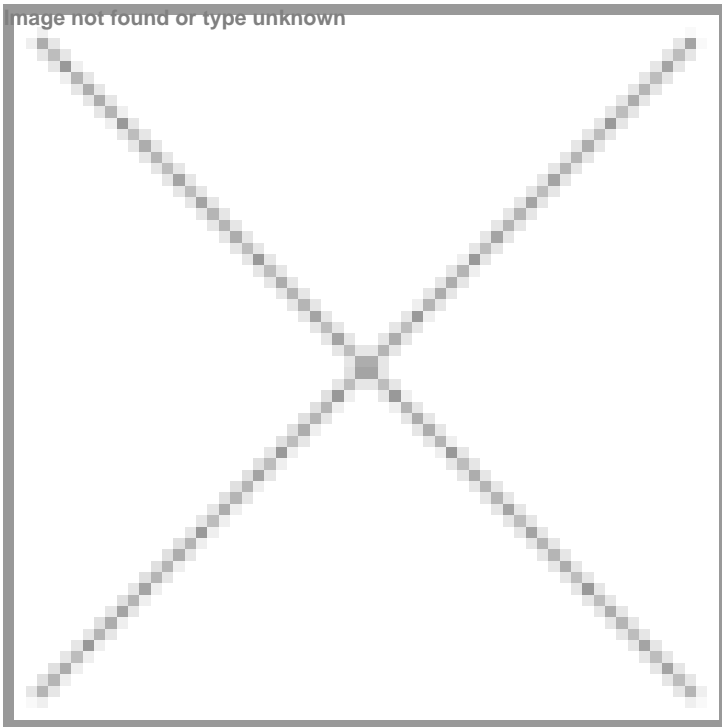


KIMS Hospitals launches Institute of Neurosciences and Centre of Excellence in Neuromodulation in Bengaluru
