IKA receives 'Top 100' innovator award



At the German SME Summit in Essen, IKA-Werke GmbH & Co. KG has been presented with an award recognizing the company as one of the most innovative medium-sized businesses in Germany. "Top 100" mentor Mr Ranga Yogeshwar honored the company with the seal of approval, IKA-Werke is "Top 100 Innovator" for the third time in a row and in 2015, reached second place in the category for companies with over 250 employees.

Analysts investigate the innovation management processes and their success using over 100 parameters across five categories. The decision on which medium-sized company is awarded the "Top 100" seal of approval is solely made by the analyst panel.
